Conditions of Entry & General Information

- 1. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving a reason.
- 2. Horses and Ponies must be 5 years old or over on the day of the competition.
- 3. All entries must be accompanied by the correct entry fee
- 4. All classes are open to Pony Club and Non Pony Club members. Non PC members must be covered by their own insurance.
- 5. Age as at 1st January 2024
- 6. The decision of the Judges and Stewards in all cases is **Final**.
- 7. Hats must comply with current Pony Club 2024 rules. All hats must have a pink Pony Club Tag (tagged by their own branch) or BE/BRC hat tag before the event. They must be worn with the chin strap correctly fastened at all times when mounted. No fixed peaks. For a full list of approved hat standards, please go to https://pcuk.org/media/giyibtuw/hat-rule-2024.pdf
- Body protectors are compulsory for XC and strongly recommended for show jumping phase, and must meet BETA 2018 (Blue/Black Label) If you wear an air jacket you must wear a Level 3 body protector underneath. Further information on the new 2024 Body Protector rule, please go to https://pcuk.org/media/3c3hiisf/body-protector-rule-2024.pdf
- 9. If used, whips for the jumping phases must be of the padded "baton" style and between 45-70cm in length.
- 10. Any objections must be handed to the Secretary in writing with a deposit of £10 within ½hr of the incident. In the event that the objection is not upheld, the deposit will be forfeited.
- 11. HEALTH & SAFETY the organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health & safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone MUST take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers & all officials & stewards.
- 12. In the event of cancellation entry fees will be returned less £5 per entry to cover expenses.
- 13. Dogs are permitted in the lorry park only and must be kept on leads at all times.
- 14. The organisers reserve the right to alter the event at their discretion.
- 15. Substitution of entries. A rider may request to substitute a horse / pony for a class that he / she has entered if the secretary is so advised before the start of the class.
- 16. Horse and Rider may not be substituted, this is in effect and completely new entry.

About the Competition

The Competition

An encouraging and low-key event designed for genuine novice riders. Competitors to be 16 years or under on 1st January 2024 Non Pony Club members are welcome.

Our aim is that all riders have a positive experience and receive a completion rosette. Rules will follow those as set down in the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2024 <u>https://docreader.reciteme.com/doc/view/id/6602b0aa8016a</u> With the following exceptions:

- Combinations may only complete in one class / section.
- Judges uphold the right to eliminate any rider that they feel is unsafe at any time during the competition.
- All competitors must present for tack inspection at least 20 mins before their start time in each phase.
- In Class 1, Section A, lead reins must be attached to the noseband only.
- Please note the new Pony Club grass reins rule for 2018.
- Assisted means ONE Assistant can be in the ring with the competitor to provide VERBAL guidance and support. Any leading will result in penalties.

Dressage Phase

- The rider must be led in Section A of classes 1
- Tests may be called in Classes 1, 2 and 3 (A) without penalty. (All assisted classes and all 40cm class) Please note at Area 12 Championships test can not be called
- Tests can not be called in Class 2(B), 3(B) 4 or 5 (All unassisted classes)

Show Jumping Phase

- The rider must be led in Section A of class 1
- The rider may be assisted by ONE person in Assisted Sections 1 (B), 2 (A) and 3 (A)
- A rider in an unassisted Section 2(B) 3(B) 4 and 5 who receives outside assistance will be penalised by 10 penalties on each occasion.

Cross Country Phase

- The rider must be led in Section A of class 1
- The rider may be assisted by ONE person in Assisted Sections 1 (B), 2 (A) and 3 (A)
- A rider in an unassisted Section 2(B) 3(B) 4 and 5 who receives outside assistance will be penalised by 10 penalties on each occasion.
- After 2 refusals at any fence, the rider may continue to the next fence but will incur 60 penalties.
- The XC will not be timed but those deemed to be going too fast will be asked to slow down.
